What is required of Oregon Residents?

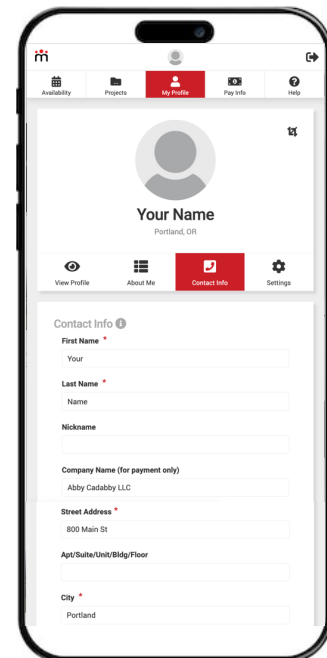
To clearly establish a contracting relationship, Oregon requires that contractors register as a company (LLC, C or S-Corp, or Partnership). Additionally, Oregon wants to see that a contractor works for multiple clients within a 12-month period. Please note that every state has unique requirements to establish contracting relationships, but Oregon does have some of the more stringent requirements than other states.

*For Oregon Residents, Mertzcrew only contracts individuals with valid EINs that are registered as a C-Corp, S-Corp, Partnership, or LLC

Your completed electronic W9 must be submitted to us before we can release payment to you. Please complete and submit the W9 form below.

REGISTRATION:

LLC/C-Corp/S-Corp: Please consult your tax advisor before making any permanent registrations. Once you decide which company structure is right for your particular situation, you can go to the IRS website and apply for an EIN. Registration is free and can typically be completed within the same day. While we can't make specific recommendations, you can find more information at www.Nolo.com

APPLICABILITY:

Any Oregon resident contracted by Mertzcrew: In accordance with Oregon state law, we do not contract Oregon residents as an individual, sole-proprietor, or single-member LLC. We know this adds additional administrative steps, but it ensures the contractor & client are in compliance with Oregon requirements.
